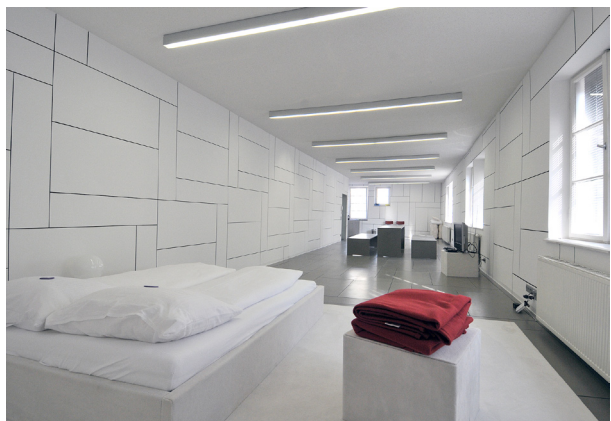


CALL FOR RESIDENCY

Offer

The stay comes with the free use of our studio flat and the existing infrastructure and includes the opportunity to prepare participation in an exhibition, a publication or an individual event.

The duration of the stay is four to six weeks, between the start of September and the end of November.

The grant is EUR 250,- per week. There is no separate reimbursement for travel expenses. Production budgets, if necessary, are negotiated on an individual basis.

Requirements

- Language skills: spoken and written command of German or English
- non-Austrian citizenship and no registered residence in Upper Austria
- minimum age 19 years
- travel or health insurance and valid visa, depending on country of origin

Application Documents

- 1 PDF document via email, containing no more than 6 DIN A4 pages, of which a maximum of 3 pages may include sketches of ideas with text and image material, and a maximum of 3 pages with CV, artistic career and work samples
- weblinks to personal home page and other online documents within the PDF file
- completed application form

Host

afo architekturforum oberösterreich (architecture forum upper austria) is a regional institution that aims to convey building culture. The association is situated in the city center of Linz, in the city's former public soup kitchen designed by architect Curt Kühne. The premises are home to two exhibition spaces, workshops, a vaulted basement and offices. A 75 sqm studio flat equipped with a bed, kitchen, bath and toilet is located in the attic.

Preamble

For 2017, afo is awarding two residencies to architects and artists who address the topics of space, architecture and city. What we desire from our guests is fresh input in terms of content, creative and dedicated work and an expanded horizon for our program.

Topic

This year's call goes out for proposals relating to the neighborhood of the afo architekturforum oberösterreich and/or to the city center of Linz. We have compiled a train of topics as food for thought:

Space as a political element – re-interpretation of spatial conditions – freedom and regimentation – public space – history and future – closeness and distance – translating and communicating.

The entry deadline is 30 June 2017.
The decision will be announced in July 2017.
